WHEREAS, the above legislation would limit cities' abilities to perform in-house projects using city personnel and inmate labor; and

WHEREAS, cities have faced revenue reductions due to property tax reform and have less funds available today than two years ago to provide services to city residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City of DeFuniak Springs performs in-house repair and maintenance on public facilities at a great cost savings to our tax paying citizens; and


WHEREAS, the City of DeFuniak Springs, like other cities across Florida, look for ways to save taxpayer dollars and provide quality services that enhance our community.
