

RESOLUTION 2015-23

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, desires to establish its sewer tap fees of the city sewer system, and;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 863 and Chapter 23, Section 23-123, of the DeFuniak Springs Municipal Code provides that said fees shall be set by Resolution, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, has determined that appropriate sewer tap fees of the city sewer system shall be set as follows:

SEWER TAP FEES:


Before any person shall newly connect any property, building or structure to the city's sewer system, they shall pay for such connection and availability for sewer, a sewer connection charge to be assessed by the superintendent in accordance with the following.

- (1) Residential customer connection, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or each living unit.
- (2) Commercial customer connection, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per connection point to the sewer system plus the greater of:
 - a. Four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for each additional living unit served by the connection point.
 - b. Six hundred dollars (\$600.00) for each additional six thousand (6,000) gallons per month above the initial six thousand (6,000) gallon increment of flow estimated through the connection point by the superintendent, such estimates of flow shall be made by the superintendent in accordance with normal flows expected from the plumbing fixtures served by the connection.
- (3) All service connections outside the city limits shall have a twenty-five (25) percent service charge in addition to the sewer tap connection fees above set forth.
- (4) In the event the city incurs any costs as a result installation of the sewer tap for having to bore under a roadway, the customer shall be responsible for paying the cost incurred for said boring.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, hereby establishes its sewer usage charges as set for the herein.
