

**RESOLUTION 2015-24**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, desires to establish its water tap fees of the city water system, and;

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 864 and Chapter 23, Section 23-123, of the DeFuniak Springs Municipal Code provides that said fees shall be set by Resolution, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, has determined that appropriate water tap fees of the city water system shall be set as follows:

**WATER TAP FEES:**

(a) For the initial installation of water service, the following tap fee shall be paid to the city:

<i>Service Pipe Size (in inches)</i>	<i>Fee</i>
3/4.....	\$1,000.00
1.....	1,100.00
1 1/2.....	1,200.00
2.....	1,400.00
3.....	1,800.00
4.....	2,200.00
5.....	3,000.00
6.....	4,000.00

All services larger than six (6) inches shall be proportionately larger in conformity with those shown above, but in no event shall the same be less than the cost of the meter and labor for installation. All taps larger than three-quarter (3/4") inches shall have the cost of the meter added to the initial cost of the tap provided for in (a). All over sixty (60) feet of water service pipe from the main to the property line of the premises shall be installed at the cost of the property owner to be served or the applicant for the service.

(b) In addition to the tap-in fee hereinabove prescribed the property owner or applicant for service shall pay the full cost of all meters larger than three-quarter (3/4) inches.

(c) Persons desiring a meter for agricultural purposes only, whereby the water does not return to the city through the sewer and already having a water tap and account, shall pay a fee of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) to have a meter installed beside the existing meter using the existing tap.

(d) Persons requiring more than one meter per tap shall pay a tap fee for each meter unless provided for in (c) above.


(e) In the event the city incurs any costs as a result installation of the water tap for having to bore under a roadway, the customer shall be responsible for paying the cost incurred for said boring.


**WHEREAS**, There shall be added to the usual water rates a surcharge of twenty-five percent (25%) on all water tap connections outside the city limits.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, hereby establishes its water usage charges as set for the herein.
