**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DEFUNIAK SPRINGS RESCINDING
RESOLUTION 2016-09 RELATING TO PUBLIC USE CITY FACILITY RENTAL FEES
& ADOPTING NEW PUBLIC USE CITY FACILITY RENTAL FEE RATES AND
RESOLUTION 2016-08 RELATING TO NON-PROFIT & GOVERNMENTAL USE
CITY FACILITY RENTAL FEES & ADOPTING NEW NON-PROFIT &
GOVERNMENTAL USE CITY FACILITY RENTAL FEE RATES**

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs City Council adopted the proposed fees for the use of City facility buildings of the DeFuniak Springs Civic Center, Chautauqua Hall of Brotherhood Auditorium, and the John V. Lawson Amphitheater in Resolution 2016-09 and Resolution 2016-08 on September 12, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of DeFuniak Springs will not charge Local, State or Federal Government for the use of our facilities; and

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs City Council wishes to update a revised City facility rental fee rate schedule according to the following:

WHEREAS, Non-Profits will only receive a reduction of fees during the annual budgeting process so they can recover rental fee charges in their annual City request for funding. Each reduced event will be charged \$90.00 so the City can recover opening and closing costs; and

WHEREAS, admission and cover charges shall only be allowed with the approval of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, should the consumption of alcoholic beverages on premises be allowed and requested by the renter, liquor liability insurance will be required by the renter naming the City as an additional insured sufficient security as determined by the City Marshal or designee and a City Attendant shall be on site at the expense of the renter, and

WHEREAS, any event with 30 or more attendees will require a City Attendant on site at the expense of the renter, and

WHEREAS, Insurance, when required, shall be provided by the renter's own insurance or through TULIP. The City shall be named as an additional insured, and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the DeFuniak Springs City Council, this resolution is hereby adopted in the regular session on this 8th day of February 2021.
