

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DEFUNIAK SPRINGS RELATING TO FACILITY RENTAL FEES

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs City Council adopted a fee schedule for the use of City facilities at the DeFuniak Springs Community Center, Chautauqua Hall of Brotherhood Auditorium, and the John V. Lawson Amphitheater; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of DeFuniak Springs to rescind and replace Resolution 2016-09, Resolution 2016-08 adopted on September 12, 2016, and Resolution 2021-04 adopted on February 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of DeFuniak Springs waives fees for any Local, State or Federal Government for the use of the facilities; and

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs City Council wishes to update a revised City facility rental fee rate schedule according to the following:


WHEREAS, Insurance, when required, shall be provided by the renter's own insurance or through TULIP. The City shall be named as an additional insured, and
