RESOLUTION 2000-05

WHEREAS, the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, has been asked to abandon the alley that runs East and West connecting with 4th Street on the east and 5th Street on the West. Said alley being adjacent to the North boundary of Lots 952, 953, 954, 955, and 956, Town of DeFuniak Springs, according to the map of Lake DeFuniak dated March 24, 1886; and said alley being adjacent to the South boundary of Lots 941, 942, 943, 944, 945, and 946, Town of DeFuniak Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has advertised its intention to abandon said alley, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to abandon any interest in the alley that runs East and West connecting with 4th Street on the east and 5th Street on the west. Said alley being adjacent to the North boundary of Lots 952, 953, 954, 955, and 956, Town of DeFuniak Springs, according to the map of Lake DeFuniak dated March 24, 1886; and said alley being adjacent to the South boundary of Lots 941, 942, 943, 944, 945, and 946, Town of DeFuniak Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to retain ten feet of said alley for utility purposes,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, to abandon the alley that runs East and West connecting with 4th Street on the east and 5th Street on the west. Said alley being adjacent to the North boundary of Lots 952, 953, 954, 955, and 956, Town of DeFuniak Springs, according to the map of Lake DeFuniak dated March 24, 1886; and said alley being adjacent to the South boundary of Lots 941, 942, 943, 944, 945, and 946, Town of DeFuniak Springs. However, the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, hereby retains the ten foot easement for utility purposes.
