NOTICE TO RECEIVE SEALED BIDS

**CITY OF DEFUNIAK SPRINGS
SRF Wastewater Improvements – Phase IIA**

This project includes the installation of a 650 to 850 gpm wastewater lift station just southeast of the I-10 and US 331 interchange, 11,100 LF of 12-inch PVC / 14-inch HDPE (12" ID) and 6,300 LF of 14-inch PVC / 16-inch HDPE (14" ID). The new forcemain will extend from the new lift station north to the WWTP. Upgrades include improvements to existing lift stations #1 and #2, and installation of 1,000 LF of 8-inch PVC / 10-inch HDPE forcemain along Bruce Street to tie-in existing lift station #1 to the new 14-inch forcemain. This project is being funded by State Revolving Fund (SRF) Clean Water Program, and FDEP Supplementary Conditions and Davis Bacon Wage Rates are applicable. The City of DeFuniak Springs encourages women owned and minority owned businesses to submit bids on the project.

All Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked: "**Sealed Bid: City of DeFuniak Springs – SRF Wastewater Improvements – Phase IIA**"

A Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the Bid shall accompany the Bid. The City of DeFuniak Springs (City) reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The City also reserves the right to reject contractors who in the City's opinion are not qualified to perform the work based on the pre-qualification package. All Bids shall be firm for a period of 90 days after opening. This includes material prices. The bid must conform to Section 287.133(3) Florida Statutes, on public entity crimes.

All bidders shall comply with all applicable state, federal, and local laws concerning licensing, registration, and regulations of contractors doing business in Florida. The City shall award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; provided however, the City reserves the right to award the contract to a bidder who is not the lowest responsive and responsible bidder if the City determines in its reasonable discretion that another bid offers the City a better value based upon the reliability, quality of service, or product of such other bidder.
